Electro-Indie duo, **Wye Oak** released a new track "**Evergreen**" as part of **Adult Swim Singles**. The single marks the first release from the group since 2018's, **The Louder I Call, the Faster It Runs**, which was hailed by **New York Times** as "...the sound of a band simultaneously delving deeper into its music and opening it up."

Over the course of a decade and five full-length albums, Jenn Wasner and Andy Stack have been "forging an audacious creative path" (**NPR Music**) as Wye Oak. With additional aliases and countless collaborations, the duo's contributions to the musical landscape have reached beyond the parameters of the project for which they're best known. With numerous releases from their solo projects and as touring members of **Sylvan Esso**, **Bon Iver**, and **Lambchop**, Wasner and Stack have had an especially fruitful few years outside of Wye Oak.

With the group's seemingly constant collaborations as producers and multi-instrumentalists with other projects, the track being recorded just weeks prior to the surprise release is just par for the course. A "sonic documentation of seasonal depression" featuring distance strings and swelling synths, the emotive track fits perfectly with the group's catalog while demonstrating their ability to incorporate an increasingly diverse array of sounds.
